

Notice of Compliance Agreement
Elections Act

February 1, 2017

This notice is published by the Chief Electoral Officer of Nova Scotia pursuant to section 299 of the *Elections Act* (the *Act*), as a result of the findings of an investigation into breaches of the *Act* in the Municipality of the County of Richmond which commenced in October 2016 and concluded with an investigation report in January 2017.

Gail Johnson of St. Peter's entered into a compliance agreement acknowledging that:

- On May 23, 2014, councillor Johnson attended a fundraising dinner for the EDA.
- The councillor sought and accepted reimbursement for the cost of one ticket to the dinner.
- The councillor was unaware that accepting funds to reimburse a contribution made to an electoral district association is a breach subsection 243(2) of the *Act*.
- The councillor agreed to reimburse the Municipality the moneys received after meeting with Elections Nova Scotia investigators.
