

Compliance Agreement

Nova Scotia Elections Act

On February 5, 2014, and pursuant to Section 294 of the Act, the Chief Electoral Officer entered into a compliance agreement with Ronald Schooten of Farmington, Nova Scotia.

The Elections Act states:

336 Every person is guilty of an offence who
(a) knowingly votes or applies to vote in an election when not eligible to do so;

On October 1, 2013, Mr. Schooten voted in the provincial general election when ineligible. Mr. Schooten is aware that as a result of his actions, he has breached provisions of the *Elections Act*.

Before entering into this Compliance Agreement, the Chief Electoral Officer has taken into consideration that Mr. Schooten has taken responsibility for the acts that have led to this Compliance Agreement.
